Resignation during the operational year

Adopted at board meeting: 2019-09-18

Should a board member wish to resign during the operational year these, steps have to be taken:

- 1. The board member in question has to contact the president and give an explanation as to why they wish to resign.
- 2. To resign the board has to decide during a legitimately summoned board meeting to dismiss the board member in question. This in order for there to be a record of said resignation as well as ensuring legitimacy and transparency in the association.
- 3. It is up to the presidency to distribute the duties of the now missing board position if necessary for the operation of the board and association.
- 4. Someone wishing to resign cannot be made to fulfill their duties in the association, but the resignation should follow point 1, and 2 presented in this steering document.

Should a board member resign during the operational year, it is expected of them to:

- 5. Continue the mission until a new board member has been elected or until the board has had the time to otherwise arrange the work in a sufficient way regarding the now empty position.
- 6. Give a proper handover to the board member elected after their resignation.
- 7. In case of an extraordinary event, such as a family tragedy, the details regarding point 5 in this steering document can be negotiated. However point 6 must be fulfilled.
